Action Items

1. Discuss and Approve a Slate of Officers.
2. Approve motion to amend Students' Rights and Responsibilities (SSR) as proposed below. The language used is in conflict with A.R.S. § 15-184(I), and does not provide basis for denying enrollment due to suspension or past discipline records. "A charter school may refuse to admit any pupil who has been expelled from another educational institution or who is in the process of being expelled from another educational institution."

Current: Is the student pending expulsion or long term suspension? Has student ever been suspended/expelled? From which school did suspension occur?

Proposed Amendment: Is the student pending expulsion? Has student ever been expelled?

3. Approve motion to revise Students' Rights and Responsibilities (SSR) as proposed below in order to reflect the current statute. "Pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-803, students are required to attend 90% of the school year, and absences will be considered excessive when the number of days absent exceeds 10%."

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Current: “Arizona State law requires attendance 85% of the time to received credit for a class. If a student is absent more than 15% of the class time in a given quarter, students will not receive credit for the class or classes.”

Proposed: “Arizona State law requires attendance 90% of the time to received credit for a class. If a student is absent more than 10% of the class time in a given quarter, students will not receive credit for the class or classes.”

4. Approve motion to amend Primary Home Language Other Than English (PHLOTE) Survey (included in the in the school enrollment packet) to include the following questions (see attached PHLOTE Survey):
 - What is the primary language used in the home regardless of the language spoken by the student?
 - What is the language most often spoken by the student?
 - What is the language that the student first acquired?

5. Approve motion to update the Enrollment Packet to include the Primary Home Language Other Than English (PHLOTE) Survey (see attached PHLOTE survey).
